Dress Code

GIRLS

Ballet and Children's Division: pink tights, leotard as specified below, pink ballet slippers and/or pointe shoes.

Modern and Contemporary: black tights, leotard as specified below, bare feet

Jazz: black tights, leotard as specified below, black jazz shoes

Tap: black tights, leotard as specified below, lace-up jazz tap shoes for level 2 and up.

Hip Hop: tank top, black sweat or black hip hop pants, sneakers

Leotard style and colors: All leotards are Mirella.

All Children's Division- Style: M201C2; Color: Pink

Level 1- Style: M207; Color: White and Mirella Skirt MS12; Color: White

Level 2- Style: M207; Color: Lilac

Level 2X- Style: M207; Color: Light Blue

Level 3- Style: M207; Color: Sea Foam

Level 3X- Style: M207; Color: Red

Level 4/4X- Style: M207; Color: Black

Level 5/5X- Style: M207; Color: Royal Blue

Level 6- Style: M207; Color: Burgundy

BOYS

Ballet and Children's Division: black tights, white t-shirt, white ballet slippers, and white socks

Modern and Contemporary: black tights, white t-shirt, bare feet

Jazz: black jazz pants, white t-shirt, jazz shoes

Tap: black jazz pants, white t-shirt, lace up tap shoes

Hip Hop: tank top, black sweat or black hip hop pants, sneakers

HAIR

All girls with hair chin length or longer must wear their hair in a traditional ballet bun for every ballet class and ponytail for all other classes. Girls and boys with very short hair must have their hair secured neatly off their face in a way that will not distract from class (headbands are not recommended because they fall out easily when children dance). Boys with long hair must secure it back in a neat ponytail for class.

CLASS ATTIRE FOR OPEN DIVISION

Appropriate dance attire in color and style of student's choice. Can include leotard and tights or form fitting exercise wear such as pants and fitness top. Ballet shoes are required for ballet class. Jazz shoes are required for jazz class. Tap shoes are required for tap class.
